Please be advised that Lattice Semiconductor Corporation has been certified and validated by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security/Customs and Border Protection (CBP) initiative "Customs-Trade Partnership against Terrorism" (C-TPAT).

Implemented in the aftermath of 9/11, C-TPAT is a joint government-business initiative to build cooperative relationships that strengthen overall supply chain and border security in order to protect our supply chain from concealment of terrorist weapons and other contraband. Through this initiative, U.S. Customs and Border Protection requests that businesses ensure the integrity of their security practices, and communicate their security guidelines to their business partners within the supply chain.

Lattice's C-TPAT status can be monitored within the C-TPAT web portal using the Status Verification Interface (SVI) number module within the portal (www.cbp.gov/CTPAT).

Please also be advised that Lattice SG Pte. Ltd. is certified under Singapore's Secure Trade Partnership (STP) program. Similar to C-TPAT, the STP is a voluntary certification program consistent with the World Customs Organization SAFE Framework of Standards to secure and facilitate global trade. Participating companies adopt robust security measures using a risk-based approach in their trading operations to improve global supply chain security.
