**Class I ODS - CFCs (Chlorofluorocarbons)**  
**MCF (Methyl Chloroform, 1,1,1-Trichloroethane)**  
**CT (Carbon Tetrachloride)**  
**Class II ODS - HCFCs (Hydrochlorofluorocarbons)**

Dear Environmental or Engineering Manager:

As you may know, on May 4, 1992, EPA issued a Proposed Rule under the United States Clean Air Act of 1990 that will require labels on containers of, and products containing or manufactured with, ODSs. The chemicals effected are both Class I and II chemicals. Parts **manufactured** with or **containing** Class I substances are targeted for warning labels by May 15, 1993. In addition, parts **containing** Class II chemicals must be labeled by this date.

In keeping with the upcoming requirements set forth by the Clean Air Act of 1990, Lattice Semiconductor Corporation (LSC) has taken a proactive stance and is committed to the goal of this legislation. Accordingly, as of May 15, 1993, LSC has eliminated all Class I ODSs from the manufacturing of **products and packing materials** that LSC supplies to our valued customers. In addition, no Lattice part **contains** any Class II chemicals.
